* Students will wash hands before and after. *



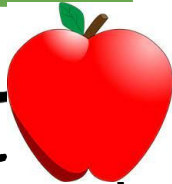

Health and Safety PLAN @ a GLANCE

- As long as conditions are favorable, masks are optional within our school building.
- We ask that parents continue to screen students each day before sending them to school. If a student is sick, please keep them at home. A student shouldn't attend school if he/she displays any symptoms of illnesses.
- If a fever of 100.4 or higher occurs, the student cannot return to school until he/she is fever free (without medication) for 24 hours. It is appreciated that a doctors note is presented if a student is seen by a physician.
- Please keep your emergency contact information current in the event we need to contact you.

Implementation of our health and safety plan is subject to change at the direction of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis in collaboration with the Indiana and Decatur County Health Departments.

School Communication:

Through this school year, the Archdiocese is transitioning to a new student information system (SIS) called PowerSchool. This system will help us keep track of attendance, grades, and other important information. It also has a component called School Messenger, which is how you will receive communications from the school. As we make the transition, we will keep you informed about how to access this data. We will continue to use Jupiter, if possible, during the transition, but we just wanted you to know about these impending changes.
