Students also learned about the importance of trustworthiness and learned about how St. Tarcisius displayed trustworthiness by defending the Eucharist. Trustworthiness is "Acting in a way that inspires confidence and trust; being reliable." Be sure to ask your student what they learned about during March and April.
